Rules and Regulations

1. Entries will be accepted on the morning of the Show in the Villages Hall between 9-11am when staging will also take place.
2. Entry fee 20p per exhibit
3. Points will be awarded in each class as follows:
 - ▶ First place 3 points
 - ▶ Second place 2 points
 - ▶ Third place 1 point

No exhibitor may enter more than two entries in a class. Only the highest placed exhibit will count towards the score for the Challenge Cup.
4. All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor. In the case of pot grown exhibits these must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least two months.
5. In the case of cut flower arrangements, aids are permitted within the confines of the container.
6. Exhibitors must supply their own vases and containers.
7. Whilst the Committee will exercise every care, they cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage and all exhibits are accepted at the exhibitor's risk.
8. The decision of the Judges will be final as to the merits of the exhibits and the decision of the Committee will be final in all matters connected with the Show. The Show will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Standards of the Royal Horticultural Show Handbook, where appropriate.
9. The winner and runner up of the awards must undertake to return the Trophies to the Club Secretary by 1st February 2018.

Section A. Daffodils (Narcissus) – all cut flowers

- Class 1** Three all yellow single blooms – trumpet variety
- Class 2** Three all white single blooms - trumpet variety
- Class 3** Three bicolour single blooms – trumpet variety

- Class 4** Three all yellow single blooms – cupped variety
- Class 5** Three all white single blooms - cupped variety
- Class 6** Three bicolour single blooms – cupped variety
- Class 6a** Three orchid flowered daffodils
-
- Class 7** Three blooms double – yellow
- Class 8** Three blooms double – white
- Class 9** Three blooms double – bicolour
-
- Class 10** Three multi-headed daffodils – yellow
- Class 11** Three multi-headed daffodils – white or bicolour
-
- Class 12** Three dwarf/miniature daffodils, single bloom, yellow
- Class 13** Three dwarf/miniature daffodils, single bloom, any colour except yellow
-
- Class 14** Three dwarf/miniature daffodils, multi-headed, yellow
- Class 15** Three dwarf/miniature daffodils, multi-headed.
Any colour except yellow
- Class 16** Three cut blooms, grown from bulbs supplied by the Club

Section B. Tulips and other flowering bulbs

- Class 17** One specimen tulip bloom of any type
- Class 18** Three specimen tulip blooms of any type
- Class 19** One container of five growing tulips of any type.
(Maximum diameter of container 8" or 200mm)
- Class 19a** One single stem of any other flowering bulb

Section C. Other Flowers

- Class 20** One vase cut polyanthus, five stems.
(mixed or all of one type)
- Class 21** One vase of cut spring flowers (not shrubs or hellebors).
Four stems, minimum of two different varieties
- Class 22** One vase of forsythia, three stems
- Class 23** One vase of cut flowering spring shrubs.
Four stems, any combination of varieties
(excluding forsythia)
- Class 24** One stem of cut hellebors
- Class 25.** A single plant grown for flowers.
(Maximum container size 10" or 254mm)
- Class 26** Five pansy heads displayed on a board or card.
Maximum size A5 (148mm x 210mm)
- Class 27** a) five pansy heads of the same colour
- Class 27** b) five viola heads mixed
- Class 27** c) five viola heads of the same colour

Section D. Flower arranging

- Class 28** Up to 12 daffodils (mixed or all of one type)
Any type of foliage may be used.
Maximum width 24" or 600mm
- Class 29** Arrangement of cut spring flowers and foliage.
Maximum height and width 9" or 230mm

The "Members Spring Show Challenge Cup"

Will be awarded to the competitor who gains most points in the Show (with their highest placed exhibit in each class)

A "Runners up" Trophy will be awarded to the competitor with the next highest points. Certificates will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed entry in each class

Entry charge is 20p per exhibit.
